




Just minutes from the city, Casper Mountain offers an easy escape into Wyoming's outdoors. Rotary Park and its waterfall provide a scenic starting point, while the nearby Bridle Trail (a favorite of locals since the 1940s) winds through dense forestry and stunning overlooks. Further into the mountain, adventurers of all levels can find trails to challenge and inspire them. From the more technical singletrack of Mid-Mountain Trail, to the varried terrain of the Muddy Mountain trail loops, Casper Mountain delivers on sweeping views and a true taste of Casper's wild backyard.



A Legacy To Protect

Casper and Natrona County have been home away from home to travelers for generations. What's kept this place wild is a shared respect for the land, its history, our trails, and our wildlife. To embrace The Wild Side is to care for it, and in doing so keeping our landscapes open, healthy, and unaltered for all those who come next.



Know Before You Go

Be sure you know where public land ends and private land begins. Know the local emergency numbers before adventuring. For professional and emergency contacts in Natrona County, see Pg. 61 of this guide.

Give Space

Natrona County has 14.5 people per square mile, meaning there's lots of room to roam. Share the trail and let others pass, be considerate and take advantage of Wyoming's vast space to give room to others and the wildlife.

Tread Lightly

One of the easiest ways to travel responsibly is to stay on designated roads and trails.

Plan Ahead

Weather can change quickly in Wyoming. Before venturing out for the day, check road conditions and weather forecasts.

Leave No Trace

Flowing through the heart of Casper, the North Platte River offers easy access to one of Wyoming's most celebrated waterways. Known for world-class fly-fishing, floating, and paddling, the river delivers endless opportunities for recreation, relaxation, and scenic western beauty year-round.

There's fishing, and then there's fishing in Casper. In the heart of Wyoming, anglers discover something truly unique: world-class trout and wild waters that deliver both a spectacle and consistently rewarding angling experiences. At the center of it all is the **North Platte River**.

Casting a line in the North Platte means tapping into one of the richest trout fisheries in the country, with some stretches boasting thousands of fish per mile, including healthy populations of trout (many in the coveted 16-20" range). Whether you're matching the hatch with a small dry fly on a calm June morning or swinging streamers through cold, oxygen-rich tailwater in late fall, days out on the river never fish the same way twice.

With easy wading access, deep-water runs, classic riffles, and boat ramps scattered throughout Natrona County, anglers get to choose how they want to approach their next catch – though the river's dynamic flows and shifting channels still demand attention. Both first-timers and seasoned veterans are kept on their toes, and even experienced anglers value the local expertise. With trusted guides and outfitters, you're always one well-placed cast away from landing a trout worthy of bragging rights. It's a river where the next rise, the next seam, and the next drift could easily become your fishing story of a lifetime.

Downstream, and just a short drive from town, **Pathfinder Reservoir** delivers a completely different Wyoming angling experience. As the state's second-largest reservoir, Pathfinder pairs deep, open water with 117 miles of shoreline and a decades-long reputation for exceptional fishing. Stocked annually by the **Dan Speas Fish Hatchery** and others statewide, the reservoir supports rainbow, cutthroat, and brown trout alongside much sought-after walleye.

While summer brings welcome challenges among the wide basins, submerged structures, and quiet coves, winter transforms the reservoir into an ice fishing destination. The annual **HAWG Ice Fishing Derby** draws anglers to chase the giants below the frozen surface. With camping, vast scenery and wildlife nearby, the reservoir offers more to explore beyond the shoreline. Anglers in the area can also enjoy the 1.7 mile interpretive trail near the historic dam, photograph the abundant wildlife, or enjoy boating, jet skiing, kayaking, and swimming in the nearby **Alcova Reservoir**.

From the famous currents of the North Platte to the wide-open water of Pathfinder, the year-round access of Natrona County's waters makes it the only place where anglers will find their guaranteed catch, this level of variety and accessibility, and the peaceful solitude in nature that Wyoming is known for.

Casper doesn't ease you into the outdoors – it throws the door open and calls you to dive in head first. This is Casper's wild side on full display: raw landscapes, high-adrenaline terrain, and immediate outdoor access that turns the curious into passionate adventurers. Grip sandstone in the morning, throttle dirt by afternoon, surf the river before dinner, and log long trail miles at sunset. Here, adventure isn't over-planned or out of reach – it's close at hand for those craving movement and momentum.



Climb Higher In Fremont Canyon

Difficulty Grades:
Beginner Friendly to Advanced

Granite formations and imposing limestone rock faces sit just south of Casper, rising sharply from the North Platte River and carving a dramatic corridor that has earned a reputation among climbers from all corners of the world. The canyon's bolted faces and overhanging routes, cracks, pockets, and edges demand precision and thoughtful movement. Every route in Fremont Canyon will test your limits, every ascent will deliver perspective, and every top-out serves as a reminder why climbers seek to go higher.



Search Farther

Stargazing



The adventures in Casper don't just end at sunset. Thanks to Wyoming's limited light pollution, nightfall reveals a wild beyond the landscapes, unfolding across the vastness of our renowned skies. While you're likely to experience clear views in town, taking a small step beyond the city lights deepens the darkness – pulling the Milky Way into view alongside seasonal meteor showers, visible planets, constellations sharp enough to track with the naked eye, and the occasional Northern Lights display. Elevated ground near Casper Mountain and along quiet country roads provides natural, wide open, year-round vantage points for stargazers. Here, patience and a willingness to look up are all that's required – a slow-burn adventure that leaves a lasting mark on adventurous spirits. If you're looking to capture the moment, **Wyoming Camera Outfitters** offers specialized rental equipment to help bring the night sky into focus.

- Best visibility: ~15-30 minutes outside town
- Best viewing of the Milky Way is on clear moonless nights!
- Bring layers – temperatures can drop quickly in the dry Wyoming landscape

Rock & Fossil Hounding

Shaped by an eccentric geological history, Natrona County preserves more than the wilds of today. Held frozen in time and scattered across the landscapes is tangible evidence of a world millions of years old – calling to those willing to slow down and look closer. Across much of the surrounding area, recreational rockhounding is encouraged under straightforward BLM guidelines (learn more by scanning the QR Code below). Agates, jaspers, petrified wood, quartz, and fossils can be easily spotted from mountaintops to canyon floors, placing ancient marine life and a turbulent geological past at your fingertips.

Hunting

Here, hunting is as inseparable from the culture as the open skies and rugged frontiers that raised us. It's a tradition practiced with respect for the surrounding public lands and the wildlife that depend on them. Our vast backyards, made up of public lands and diverse terrain, are open to those who come prepared to venture farther into the wild roots of Casper and Natrona County. Those willing to trek, track, and to join a tradition defined by skill, stewardship, and a deep connection to the ecosystems that sustain this wild place we – and countless species – call home.

Whitewater Park

On the water, the **Platte River Whitewater Park** proves that Casper's Wild Side isn't only found on the edges of town — it runs straight through the middle of it. Built directly into the North Platte River, the park features engineered waves and channels that create reliable surfing features across a range of flows. Its standout front wave has earned recognition from paddlers well beyond Wyoming, offering a smooth, powerful face that rewards control and confidence while remaining approachable enough for progression. With easy access just minutes from downtown, just park, gear up, and drop in.

Trail Running

Casper's Wild Side isn't just about short bursts of adrenaline. It's about endurance, the kind that builds over miles, elevation, and time spent in solitude on the trails. Natrona County's trail system has quietly become a hub for ultra running, drawing athletes who prefer dirt over pavement and solitude over crowds. Rolling singletrack and open terrain give runners space to stretch their limits and find rhythm in the landscape.

Casper's growing ultra-running community fuels that charge year-round, with local races that attract runners from across the region. Events like **Skunk Hollow Sneaker Chase**, Wyoming's only backyard ultra, and the **Night Crawler**, a 12-hour nighttime endurance event, place runners directly into the area's diverse terrain and welcoming race culture. Whether you're toeing the line for your first ultra or chasing a new personal best, the local running scene is supportive, driven, and unapologetically gritty. Training here means learning to embrace the high altitude, constant elevation change, and tough competition, while loving every mile of it.

- If road running is more your scene, the **Casper Marathon** offers a challenge and a front-row view of the city to runners of all levels!
- Casper's trails are exposed and variable - expect wind, sun, & changing footing. Start early, carry layers, watch for wildlife, and download a route before heading out.
- Climate: Casper's elevation & dry climate can mask how much water runners are burning off. Stay hydrated and remember that sunglasses, sunscreen and a hat go a long way - even on cooler days!

Off-roading

If horsepower is more your style, turn your tires toward **Poison Spider OHV Park**. Right in Casper's backyard, this is where the Wild Side truly roars. The park sits on the site of a former bentonite mine and offers instant access to trail blazers and all motorized vehicles! ATVs and dirt bikes to UTVs and 4x4's. Put your rig and yourself to the test in the 284-acres of rocky ascents, hill climbs, engineered obstacles and wide open mud play pits. No long drive, no staging hassle, just strap in and put your skills and your rig to the ultimate off-roading test!

- Open year-round.
- There's no fee to ride in the area.
- Non-residents must display a Wyoming OHV sticker (permit).
- ~ 300 total acres of terrain to explore.

Live Music & Outdoor Concerts

From big name headliners to small-town crooners and timeless professional orchestras, Casper is home to a rich array of listening experiences. Larger venues like *David Street Station* and the *Ford Wyoming Center* host renowned performers like Hozier and Ian Munsick, while intimate spaces like *The Bloomery* and the proscenium stages of local schools provide the perfect settings for folk artists and classical ensembles. A cornerstone of Wyoming's cultural tapestry, the *Wyoming Symphony Orchestra* has inspired audiences for generations (with regular performance seasons each October-May), while the newer *Bloomery* invites summer visitors to sunset concerts complete with local beverages under the stars.

Museums & Galleries

Casper's museums and galleries invite visitors to slow down, explore, and create. The *Nicolaysen Art Museum (The NIC)* showcases rotating themed contemporary and Western exhibits, featuring impressive pieces from around the world, while *ART321* (located in one of the historic buildings of the Old Yellowstone District) is a welcoming space for creativity and connection. Both are treasure troves for art enthusiasts, offering drop-in and sign-up classes for anyone wanting to try a new medium or stretch their creative legs. Beyond their gallery walls and gift shops, these spaces host annual events (like *NICFest* in June & the *Holiday Market* in December) where artists gather to sell their handmade goods and visitors are encouraged to wander, wonder, and get inspired.

✈ Every Thursday in summer, downtown Casper hosts *Art Walk* – a free, walkable evening event with local vendors, live music, food trucks and community activities!

Downtown Casper is where the city's character shines bright. Mornings begin with the hiss of espresso machines and the smell of fresh coffee, while evenings settle into laughter and conversation drifting along the sidewalks. Shared tables, familiar faces, and locally made products shape a community culture that invites everyone to connect with each other and our one-of-a-kind city.

Start your day the way locals do: with a hearty breakfast at *The Wooden Derrick Café*. Inviting and unhurried, griddles sizzle and coffee steams as ranchers, business professionals, and visitors gather over generous plates of comfort food. The biscuits and gravy are legendary, and the atmosphere feels easy and familiar – channeling the spirit of early-morning Wyoming. Just down the block you'll find *CitiWerks Café*, Casper's newest downtown coffee shop. The cafe adds a uniquely modern twist to the landscape. Sunlight fills the space as craft

espresso pours and laptops open around communal tables. Connected to a coworking hub, CitiWerks blends caffeine and creativity, serving bold brews and light bites that invite you to settle in, whether briefly or for the longhaul.

When lunchtime rolls around head to *Himalayan Indian Cuisine*, one of our most surprising and flavorful local gems. This spot adds tastes of India and aromas of turmeric, cardamom, cumin, and ginger (with your choice of spice level) to Casper's culinary scene. From rich curries and steaming momos (a local favorite) to freshly baked naan, every bite feels like an exploration.

The afternoon is best spent wandering. Downtown's walkable streets are lined with galleries, boutiques, and locally owned shops offering made-in-Wyoming goods, western wear, outdoor gear, and uniquely-Casper finds. Murals and public art pieces add vibrant colors that pop off the historic brick walls, and vintage-style record and toy shops brim with nostalgia. Plus, the selection of tucked-away bookstores inviting you to browse their unique collections – some vintage, some new, and even some dedicatedly-spooky.

As the day winds down, downtown breweries begin to fill. With eight local breweries, Casper has become a destination for craft beer lovers. **Mountain Hops Brewhouse**, **Oil City Brewing**, and **Black Tooth Brewing** each offer their own atmosphere, unique taste, and ongoing events – making for easy conversation wherever you find yourself!



End your day at the **Branding Iron** delivers bold flavors and inventive takes on Wyoming classics, with burgers regularly dubbed the best in the state. Their Kona burger, which includes grilled pineapple, jalapeño coleslaw, and teriyaki sauce, will do wonders to your taste buds and is as Instagram worthy as it is delicious.



While you're here... it's a truly Casper experience to pickup something sweet from **Donnell's Candies**, a beloved downtown fixture since 1956. Packed with handmade chocolates, fresh caramel corn, and seasonal specialties, Donnell's feels like stepping back in time in the best way possible. Kids and adults alike light up when they walk inside, and it's nearly impossible to leave without a box of chocolates or a bag of their famous butter toffee.



The Old Yellowstone District

A Lens into The Past, A Taste of The Present, and A Glimpse at What's Next

Casper's **Old Yellowstone District** is one of downtown's earliest sectors. Having weathered its share of economic highs and lows – from crowded sidewalks and thriving storefronts during the height of the oil boom to the quiet streets and empty windows of the late 2000s – today, it's a neighborhood transformed. Its walkable streets once again invite exploration. Historic brick buildings are filled with locally owned restaurants, breweries, shops, and gyms while



a new six-story apartment building brings residents back to the city's roots. Grab a locally brewed beer and deep-dish pizza at **Cygnat Brewing**, or explore Casper's art scene at **Glow Neon** and **ART321**. With more people living, working, and gathering here again, the district has regained a sense of everyday energy – a momentum you can feel street by street. Just a few blocks east, the rest of Downtown Casper unfolds to welcome you with boutique shopping, handcrafted gifts and souvenirs at local shops like **WYO Made**, and hidden gems waiting to be discovered.

The History of Downtown Casper

Founded in June 1888, fourteen months before Wyoming achieved statehood, Casper took shape at the crossroads of McKinley and A Streets. Once home to drug stores, saloons, blacksmith shops, and bootleggers, much of downtown's character comes from its historical buildings constructed between the early 1900s and 1920s. Community institutions like the **Natrona County Library**, built in 1906, and **The Rialto Casper** (then known as the Rialto Theater), opened in 1921, still operate in their original locations. The theater stood while Casper moved through the sound-film era into the comedy and live entertainment venue it is

today, while homes like the **Marvin L. Bishop House** reflect the city's early civic and agricultural legacy, and legendary gathering places like the **Wonder Bar** drew national figures like Ernest Hemingway.

Today, Casper invites visitors to explore its preserved architecture, vintage signage, and rich stories of clever prohibition-era smuggling and early women's leadership on foot with the **Downtown Casper Historical Walking Tour**. Lose yourself in Casper’s charming downtown and stroll along our winding streets to check out locally owned businesses. From coffee shops and boutiques to thrift stores, oddity shops, and tattoo parlors, downtown truly covers it all. Best explored at a leisurely pace, a few must-visit stops include *ALMA Home*, *Mustard Seed*, *Ugly Bug Fly Shop*, *Metalmark Studios*, and *Forever Femme*.

Casper’s Shopping Districts

Casper’s shopping isn’t just contained to one area, but spread out over several easy-to-explore districts and plazas. In Downtown Casper, every other block has its own plaza including the *Atrium Plaza*, *Market Square*, and the *Wolcott Galleria*.

To the south of town, near the base of the mountain, is the *Sunrise Shopping Center*, while on the east side visitors can enjoy a concentration of big-box stores at *Blackmore Marketplace*, *Triangle Plaza*, and *Eastridge Mall*.

And for those who live for the thrill of the thrift, Natrona County has no shortage of thrift shops and vintage stores! Scattered across town, each with its own niche, these local spots are perfect for visitors seeking those diamond-in-the-rough and retro treasures.

At the center of it all is *David Street Station*, one of the city's most magnetic gathering places. 





History & Museums

Casper's Storied Past & Interactive Museums

Long before Casper had a name, this stretch of the North Platte River served as a crossroads. Indigenous peoples followed its bends and the wildlife it sustained, leaving stories and knowledge that shaped the land long before settlement. Later came trappers, mountain men, and emigrant wagons pressing west along routes that still echo through today's trail systems.

The arrival of the railroad transformed Casper from a crossing into a community. Downtown grew into a bustling center of commerce and entertainment for travelers, while the Old Yellowstone District developed with early industry. The boom-and-bust cycles of oil, ranching, and railroads tested resolve, but time and time again Casper adapted.

Cattlemen and sheepherders shared the land with roughnecks, entrepreneurs, and educators – blazing trails as early as 1869 when Wyoming became famous as the "Equality State" for being the first to grant women the right to vote. The Casper of today reflects that same historic willingness and grit to challenge convention and redefine progress.

National Historic Trails Interpretive Center

Casper sits at the heart of some of America's most significant migration routes in history, best explored at the **National Historic Trails Interpretive Center**. Overlooking the North Platte River, the center's interactive exhibits allow visitors the chance to experience the past and step into the stories of the Oregon, California, Mormon, and Pony Express trails. Nearby iconic trail landmarks like **Independence Rock** and **Martin's Cove** reveal the hope, hardship, and resilience of those who dared to journey west.

✈ Follow these iconic trails by wagon with Morris Carter & **Historic Trails West**, and experience the sights and stories of the trails firsthand!

The Mormon Trail & Martin's Cove

The Mormon Trail marks a significant chapter of westward migration through central Wyoming. Southwest of Casper, **Martin's Cove** preserves one of the trail's most powerful stories. In 1856, members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and the Martin and Willie handcart company were stranded here by early winter storms, testing the limits of endurance and faith. Today, the center's interpretive resources and hands-on experiences invite visitors to discover more about the challenges, rescue efforts, and resilience that define this pivotal moment in trail history.

Wyoming Veterans Memorial Museum

The **Wyoming Veterans Memorial Museum** honors the service and sacrifice of Wyoming's veterans across generations. Located in one of the original buildings on the former WWII Casper Army Air Base, the museum features exhibits, artifacts, and personal testimonies that preserve the state's military legacy and offers a meaningful space for education, reflection, and remembrance.

Tate Geological Museum

The **Tate Geological Museum** brings thousands of fossils and mineral specimens from Wyoming's deep past together. Located on the **Casper College** campus, highlights include: Dee, the 11,600 year old Columbian Mammoth, a juvenile T. Rex, and other Wyoming-found dinosaur fossils. Interactive exhibits explore ancient seas and shifting landscapes, with staff offering free fossil identification to anyone who thinks they may have stumbled upon a piece of Wyoming past!

Founded in 1889, Casper was built by people who didn't wait for permission – pioneers, ranchers, railroad crews, roughnecks, and rodeo riders who carved out a life where grit and open space ruled the day. Those roots still run deep here, but Casper has never been a place that stands still.

This is the Wild Side of the West – where hard work, independence, and community remain the backbone, and a new generation brings creative fire and fresh energy. You'll feel it in legendary events like the *College National Finals Rodeo*, and see it in contemporary Western style, locally owned businesses, and a culture that welcomes bold ideas as readily as it honors traditions.

In Casper, the West isn't preserved behind glass. It's lived – on the river, in the arena, on downtown streets, and under wide-open skies. This is a place still being shaped by the same pioneering spirit that started it all, where the West keeps evolving and the Wild Side runs strong.

Rodeo

College National Finals Rodeo June 16th-22nd, 2026

Every June, Casper welcomes one of its most anticipated events of the year, the **College National Finals Rodeo**. Rodeo has historic roots in Casper, and for more than 25 years the CNFR has carried that legacy forward by bringing over 400 of the nation's top collegiate athletes to our mountain town to vie for national titles on the dirt-covered arena floor of the **Ford Wyoming Center**. From the first grand entry to the final championship ride, the energy in the arena is electric with families, alumni, rodeo fans, and visitors filling the stands, setting attendance records, browsing the tradeshow and vendors, and celebrating the spirit of the West. Many athletes who ride in Casper are already performing at the highest level or go on to professional circuits, giving fans an early look at future competitors in the sport's premier championship, the National Finals Rodeo.

Across the parking lot, the festivities extend beyond the arena into the **WYO Sports Ranch** and **The Mercantile**. A large-scale Wyoming trade show, this week-long event adds to the rodeo energy with dozens of local and traveling vendors, family-friendly activities, and music.


Saddle Up In Style

WHERE THE BEST COMPETE



LOCAL TEAMS





